7. NOW DOWN TO BUSINESS!!

You will have already noticed that there are a significant number of enclosures or attachments this Newsletter. Here is a brief outline of these documents:

- A. <u>UP-DATE OF INFORMATION</u>. It is not necessary for you to return this sheet with your replies, but merely to indicate on a separate sheet, the number of the question you are answering., i.e., 1 "YES," 2 "e-mail". 11 "Will sort some out" etc. Some questions may not be able to be answered immediately, that's fine, but it would help with the preparation of the database if I could have replies to easily-answered questions;
- B. <u>LIST OF FULL MEMBERS</u>. Have a look at this list and use it to help me out PLEASE!! I am having a great deal of difficulty in sorting out who is related to which memberof the Witheridge family! I shall be grateful if you can let me know any of the members listed who are CLOSE relatives to you. - C. <u>BASIC PEDIGREE SHEET</u>. Where I have already had a Pedigree sheet from you (mostly newer members), I am \ sending you a copy of that basic pedigree sheet. Please check that the information is correct and, if you can, fill in any blanks and return the form to me. (Just let me know any alterations to the form if you want to keep the original yourself and do not have photocopying facilities). If I do not already have this information, I am attaching a blank form for you to complete and send back to me, together with an example form already completed by Barbara Finemore. The completed basic pedigree sheet for each member will be placed in a confidential file to be handed over to future Secretaries of the Society.
- D. <u>S.A.E.</u> All UK members who receive this Newsletter by snail-mail are being provided with a Stamped addressed envelope. Please do make sure when returning mail with any enclosures, that the correct stamp value is on the envelope. Overseas members and those receiving items by e-mail you will receive, if you have not already done so, an invitation to set up a drop-box. If and when I get confirmation that you have agreed and successfully set up your box, I will put the enclosures into your drop-box rather than risk sending confidential information via e-mail. Additionally, it will mean that you can return items by putting them into your drop-box. Please send me an e-mail whenever you have placed items in the drop-box.
